Shows and Sale

We will be doing as much as possible in person, though not all details have been ironed out.

Show at the Fairgrounds, Sell Online

This year, participants will be expected to participate in their required showmanship and market animal conformation at the designated show site for the 2021 Washington County Fair. Please ensure that participants are submitting their fair entries to 4-H and/or FFA to ensure they will be eligible for the sale.

The online sale will allow for pre-bidding this year, just like last year. This means that buyers can bid on your animal ahead of time before the sale. When you animal goes across the sale block during the live virtual sale, the pre-bids that your animal has already received will serve as the floor price for the auctioneer to start bids at.

Buyer letters! Please take some time to contact your buyers before the sale. Invite them to come and watch you show during your market or showmanship class! The auction committee has published a guide for how to write a successful buyer letter. It is posted on the website. Pursue your add-ons.
