What To Expect

The WCLA is excited to proceed with in-person auction animal weigh ins. While we are working to keep weigh in as normal as possible, please note the changes below:

- Families are expected to get their hogs into the cans to be weighed. Please come organized and prepared. If you have multiple hogs in your trailer, consider marking them with a crayon to easily identify hogs prior to putting them into the can.
- Participants load hogs into the can, WCLA member weighs hog and returns it to participant.
- You will not be able to congregate around the scale. We will inform you of the weight of your animal. However, to avoid excess people, we ask that you wait by your trailer while we weigh.
- Participants are still expected to participate with as much of the weighing process as possible.

Please Note: There will be no public restroom access during weigh in. The Cloverleaf Building will not be available for use of the restroom either. Please plan accordingly.

Before arriving, please preregister your hogs online on the WCLA Swine web page.

This is an in-person weigh in. Please bring your hogs!

COVID GUIDELINES FOR WEIGH IN

- 1. **Wear a face mask.** All attendees of weigh in must wear a face mask while they are weighing in their animals
- 2. **Socially distance at least six feet apart** from people outside of your household while you are weighing animals.
- 3. Parents and Participants out of the vehicle ONLY. Siblings are welcome to come along, but are required to remain in the vehicle for the weigh in process
- 4. Please **wait inside your vehicle** in line, while we weigh market animals. When it is your turn, we will prompt you.
- 5. **Please use hand sanitizer** generously
- 6. If you do not feel well, please refrain from attending weigh in and contact the Auction Committee through our website.
- 7. Gloves are encouraged but not required.

Pre-Registration: What is This?

To avoid unnecessary documentation exchange with blue cards, the WCLA has decided to open online pre-registration on our website. Before attending weigh in, please pre-register your animals. You must complete this form for each animal you are going to bring to weigh in. If you are weighing a backup hog, you must complete this twice.
